Annual Meeting Scheduled in November

Page One will be having it's Annual Meeting November 23 at the Stanley Baptist Church beginning at 6:30 pm. This is an important meeting. Member churches are asked to have a designated church member at this meeting.

Each year in our annual meeting a report is made of the accomplishments, needs, issues and more, so that meeting participants can take this information back to the churches and businesses they represent. Page One desires to have an informed public. In addition a financial report is submitted for the past year and a annual budget is adopted for the coming year. Officers will be elected.

Each member church is entitled to two voting delegates. These voting delegates are invited to attend the monthly meeting of the Board of Directors as well. In case you are wondering who a member church is, any church in Page County can simply become a member by expressing a desire to be a member in writing to the President of Page One.

Page One was created in 1977 when 76 churches came together to form a organization that could help the needy families in Page County. This organization became Page One. These churches also promised to support Page One with both

volunteers and financially. Sadly the number of active member churches has declined. The need for Page One is greater than ever. The number of needy families in Page County has continued to grow (see below). Over 400 families per month are provided with food or financial assistance.
